



GENERAL CONTENT GUIDELINES FOR rCRISPR

While we're extremely grateful for you taking the initiative to upload content on the server, we do have some reservations on what is appropriate and acceptable for it.

Here are some guidelines regarding the same:-

Acceptable content: You may upload content that is relevant to:

- 1.) Studies
- 2.) Entertainment
- 3.) Research
- 4.) College Acadmica
- 5.) College Event Pictures

All this may include documents, videos, softwares etc.

Prohibited content: You may not upload content that is:

- 1.) defamatory
- 2.) abusive
- 3.) threatening
- 4.) NSFW

This includes content that contains malware, viruses, or other harmful code.

Note that this server is managed by the students of IIITN but is subject to scrutiny by the administration. Any content up there that can be deemed inappropriate will lead to the permanent shutting down of the server for good and there's nothing we'll be able to do in that event. This can be detrimental to our cause for you guys as well so we urge you all to use your rational thinking while uploading the content and ensure that the server remains a safe and useful resource for all students to use.

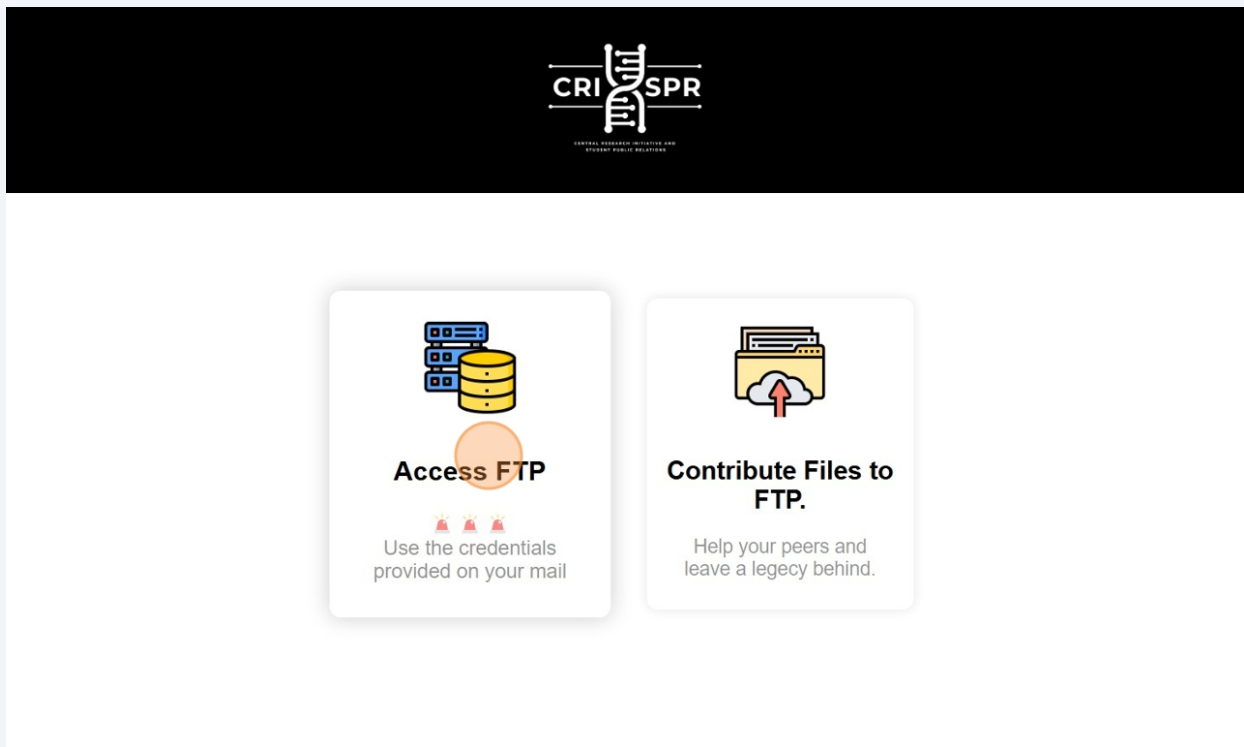

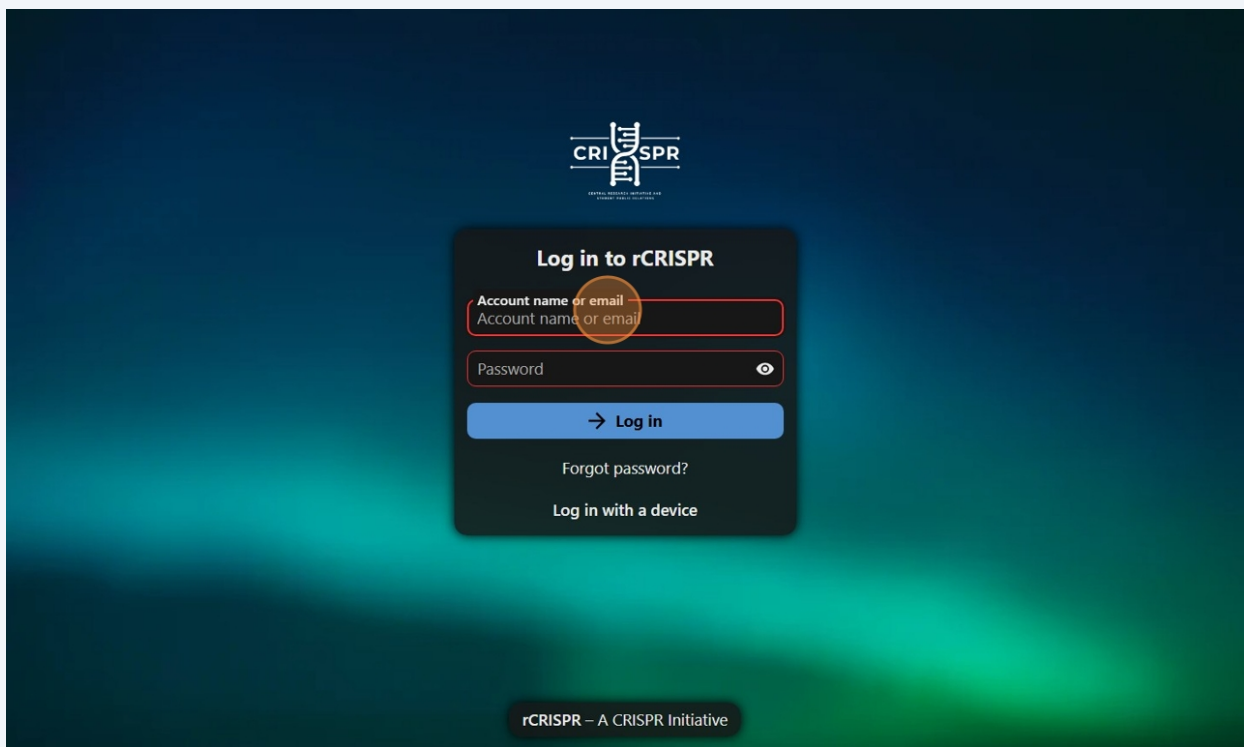

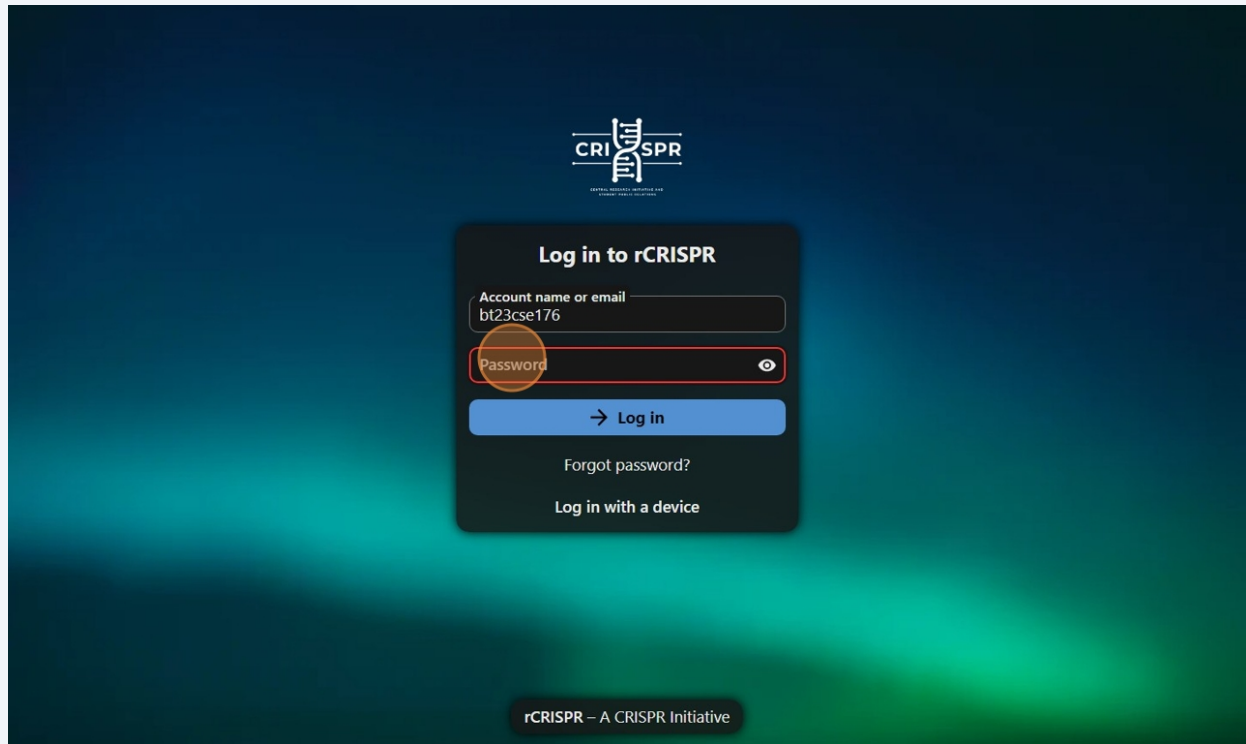


4 Click the "Account name or email" field.



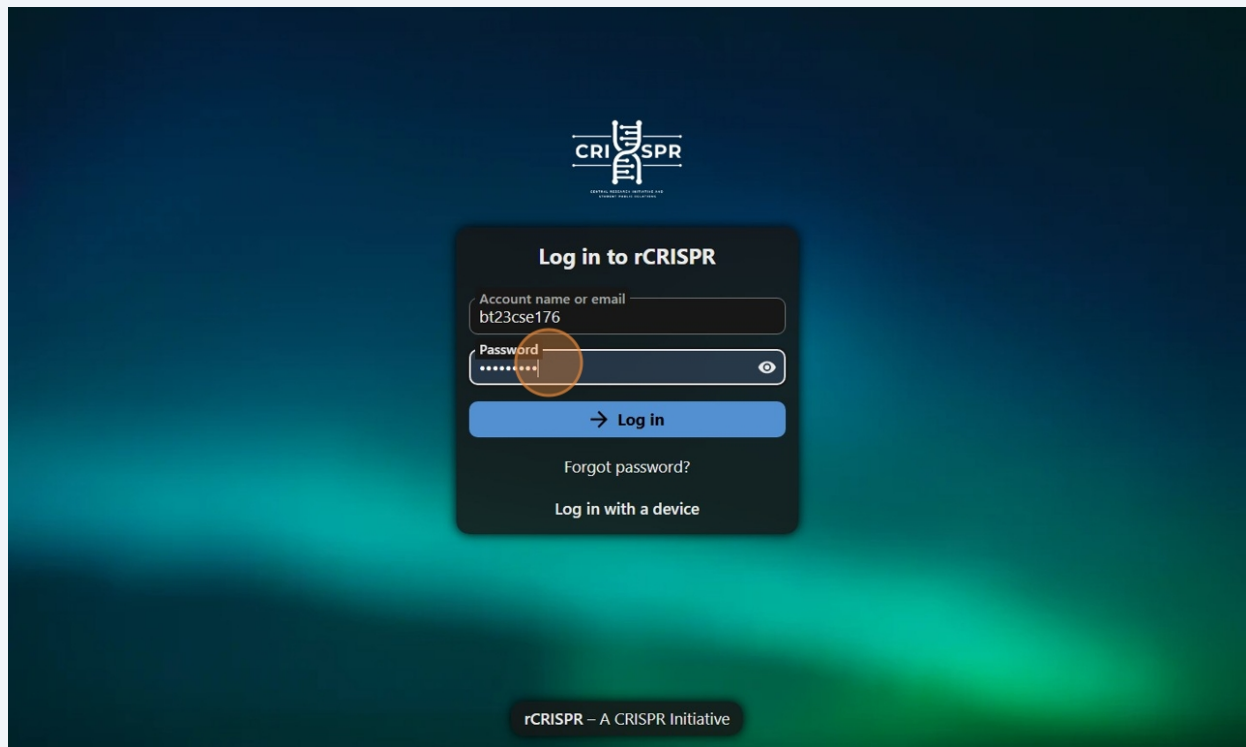

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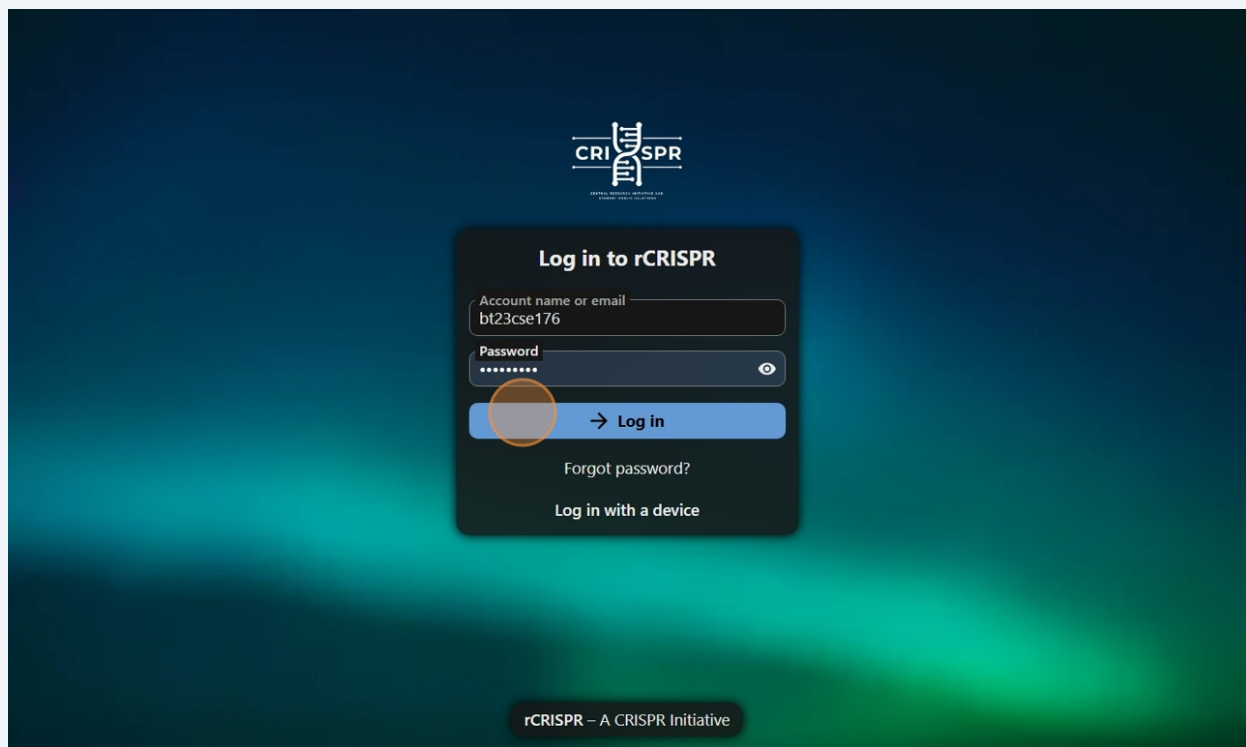
